Professional Designations

The Qualified 401(k) Administrator (QKA) Designation and the Qualified Pension Administrator (QPA) Designation are both professional designations awarded by the American Society of Pension Professionals and Actuaries (ASPPA).

To earn the QKA designation, candidates must successfully complete four sequential exams. The four levels of the exam test a wide range of retirement plan topics, including retirement plan fundamentals and advanced topics covering plan design, administration and compliance. To earn the QPA designation, candidates must first successfully complete the four exams required for the QKA and take two additional tests covering advanced topics in defined contribution and defined benefit plans.

In addition, to testing requirements, QKA and QPA professionals must have a minimum of two years experience in retirement plan related matters and 40 hours of Continuing Professional Educations credits in a two-year-cycle.
